

Work Safe Policy Statement – 2017

South West Steel Supplies Ltd promote a Work Safe Policy (Or Refusal to Work Policy) for it's employees and subcontractors while working on their sites and workshops.

Every employee and subcontractor working for the company has the right to refuse to carry out work if they feel it is not safe to do so.

Situations arising which lead to a person refusing to work under these terms, must be reported immediately to the management concerned and no work should re-commence until the issued has been satisfactorily resolved.

South West Steel Supplies Ltd additionally provides a confidential reporting arrangement through Staff safety representatives, our Health and Safety Advisors and the HSE. This information is provided through induction briefings, notice boards and in the Company Health and Safety Policy.

Managers, Supervisors, Employees and subcontractors are encouraged to report unsafe acts and near miss events.
